### WHAT DOES "SILOSO" MEAN?







**FORT SILOSO** has the largest collection of guns in Singapore. You will get to see guns in all shapes and sizes collected from different parts of Sentosa and Singapore.

There were powerful guns positioned at Fort Siloso to protect Singapore from enemy attacks by sea! Did you know that the guns were named based on the width of the gun muzzle or weight of the ammunition shell they used?

**COMPARE THE TWO PICTURES BELOW: CAN YOU SPOT THE DIFFERENCES?** 



Answers: Ammunition shells were loaded from the front of the gun barrel. Shorter gun barrel Older type, takes time to load from the front and short firing distance



Answers: • Ammunition shells were loaded from the rear of the gun barrel. • Longer gun barrel • Upgraded, faster to load and long firing distance




# HERITAGE TRAIL
