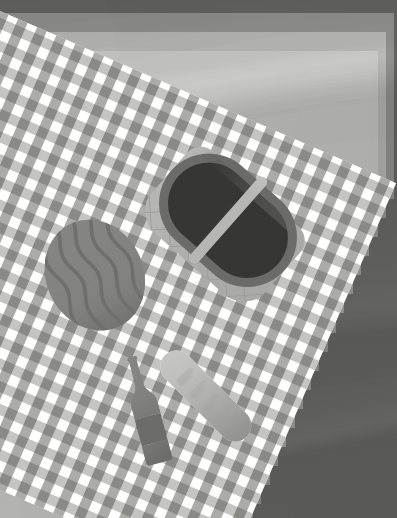

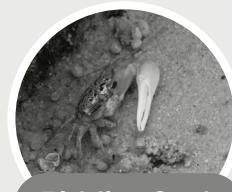

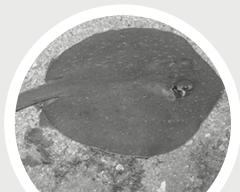

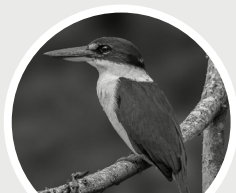

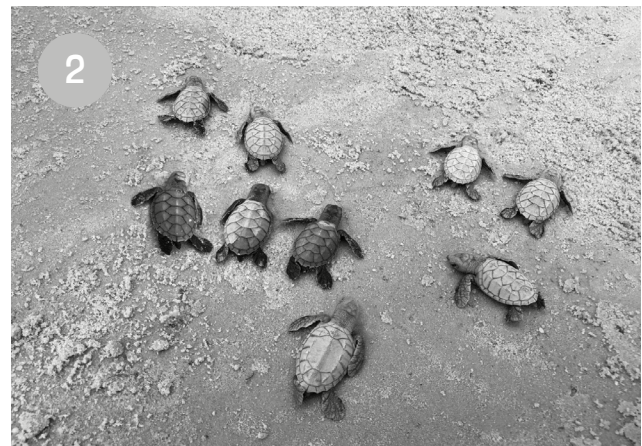
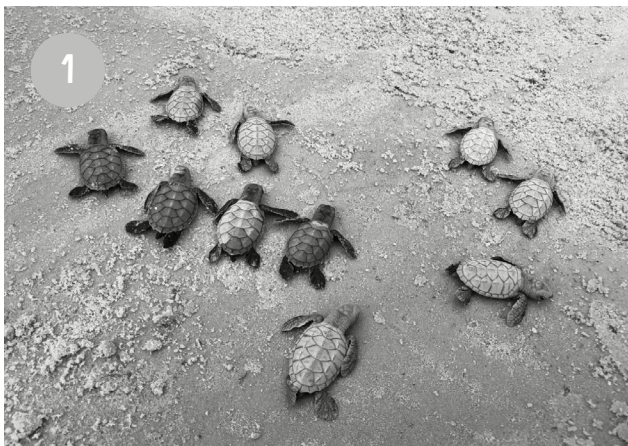
TURTLES ASHORE!

Hawksbill Turtles live in the waters around Singapore. The turtles feed on marine animals such as sponges and jellyfish. After leaving their nests as newly hatched turtles, they spend all their time at sea. Only the adult females will return to shore to nest.

Each nest can contain up to 200 eggs, sometimes more. Every little baby turtle is important as these turtles are critically endangered around the world. In Sentosa, we protect their nests and check the babies before we release them back to sea.
