



Journey over breath-taking aerial views of jungle, sand and sea on the Sentosa Line Cable Car as it takes you to over 20 attractions on Sentosa.

### **iFly Singapore Sports Education Programme**



The tour starts with a video on the introduction to indoor skydiving and skydiving. This will allow students who are new to this sport to understand foundational information about it. This is followed by a visit to the fan deck. They will go through a flight safety training and a dry run of the basic belly fly position by our instructors. Students will proceed to do warm-up exercises before gearing up in the flight suits and other safety equipment. After this, students will take their flight and practice their belly fly position in the wind tunnel! Each student will have 1 skydive (of 45 secs) minimum. Each flight is equivalent to skydiving from 12,000 ft and deploying a parachute at 3,000 ft. Lastly, they will be presented with a certificate of flying.

Learn survival skills schools don't teach you. The aim is to place students in a new learning environment outside their norms where they are able to interact and attain useful skills for life.

Learn about the diversity of life beneath the ocean, the relationships between marine animals and important conservation priorities such as coral bleaching and plastic pollution. An activity booklet complements the facilitated tour.









### Introduction

This is the trail that allows you to discover the heritage side of Sentosa, covering over 30 carefully conserved heritage trees and buildings. Along the way, other unmissable sites include Singapore's only fully-restored military fort, Fort Siloso.

### **Heritage Features**

#### A British Hospital

Built in the 1880s, this building is one of the oldest on Sentosa. First used as a hospital for British troops stationed on the island, it continued to be used for the same function during the Japanese Occupation and Post-Occupation years until the 1950s, when it became the British Royal Artillery Training Centre.

#### Madame Tussauds



#### B Fort Siloso

Located on the west of the island, this historic fort has been conserved as one of the key heritage monuments of Singapore. Built by the British in 1880s to guard the narrow western entrance to



Keppel Harbour, it later served to guard the western approaches to Singapore during World War II.

#### C Mount Imbiah Battery

Mount Imbiah is one of two protected nature areas on Sentosa, tucked away from the island's hustle and bustle. A forestcovered hill with a 1.8km-long trail network leads you on an unforgettable journey to discover the wonders of nature.

This defence post, located at the summit of Mount Imbiah, 60m above sea level, was built in the 1880s and by the First World War, was emplaced with a 9.2 inch coast gun. It served as an examination battery to screen all merchant vessels entering the Singapore harbour.

#### D Sentosa Nature Discovery

Just like the historical fort and pre-war heritage buildings on Sentosa that were re-purposed for other uses, the defunct monorail stations which were decommissioned in 2005 have been converted for new uses such as hotels, restaurants, attractions and offices. A result of one such conversion is the Sentosa Nature Discovery where you can now explore the gallery of interactive exhibits to brush up on your Science Processing Skills: Observe, Classify, Compare and Infer.







### **Heritage Trees**

#### 1 Tanjong Tree (Mimusops elengi)

An evergreen tree that can grow up to 20m in height. Its crown is round, and leaves are simple with wavy leaf margins. With small, white and sweet-smelling flowers, its fruits are orange-red in colour with velvety skin and contain a single large hard seed. The tree has many medicinal uses, for example: The leaves are used to ease headaches, the bark for the treatment of pimples and the roots used to soothe sore throats.


#### 2 Leban/Malayan Teak (Vitex pinnata)

This evergreen tree can grow up to 30m in height. Its bark is pale-grey to yellowish-brown in colour and is sometimes shallowly fissured. The flowers are blueish-white to purplish and its fruit is about 7-13mm in diameter. In traditional medicine, a decoction of the tree bark is used to cure stomach aches. Its leaves can be made into a poultice and used in the treatment of fevers and wounds.

#### **3** Broad-leafed Mahogany (Swietenia macrophylla)

A large deciduous tree that grows up to 30m in height. Its crown is round, dense and dark green in appearance. The trunk is broad, buttressed, with dark grey scaly bark, with dark glossy green leaves. Its flowers are fragrant, pale-green to yellow in colour and grow in large bunches arising from the axils of the leaves. Its fruits are distinctive, large heavy woody pods, brown in colour, splitting into 5 valves to release numerous flat single-winged seeds.

#### 4 Nyatoh Puteh (Palaquium obovatum)

This large tree with a cylindrical crown produces sticky latex and has leathery lead blades. It can only be found in a few locations around Singapore.



#### S Angsana (Pterocarpus indicus)

The Angsana, commonly found around Singapore, can grow to above 30m tall. These ornamental trees are often planted along roads and expressways to provide shade for pedestrians and to act as sound buffers for abutting buildings. Standing near the entrance of the resort is Singapore's largest tree, measuring 27m in height and 10.2m in girth.

#### 6 Sea Apple/Jambu Laut (Syzyglum grande)

This versatile and highly-tolerable tree can withstand coastal conditions that are hot and sunny with strong winds. In the past, it was even used as a firebreak - a barrier to slow or stop the progress of a wildfire. It produces large, white flowers that attract birds and bees. Singapore's only one such heritage tree of this species is found on Sentosa.



### Sentosa Nature **Discovery Trail**





Designed for students to enjoy nature and have fun at the same time, the interactive exhibits will guide them through Science Process Skills such as Observe, Classify, Compare and Infer. This will be followed by a tour through the forest where they will learn about its layers, ecology, flora and fauna. Our young explorers will gain a better understanding of potential threats and the effects of human impact.

#### Introduction to Geology Gallery

Have you always been curious about how Singapore and Sentosa came to be? Do join us at the new Geology Gallery where you can unlock the secret behind the formation of our Island Home, where it showcases earth processes and rock formation, geological map, coastal forests, rock samples and fossils. Come and experience the amazing geological formations on Singapore and Sentosa Islands while learning how important geology is for our day to day life!











### Fort Siloso



Built in the late 19th century, Fort Siloso is the only preserved coastal fort in Singapore. It is home to a wealth of WWII artefacts, including coastal guns, and the remains of fortified military structures and tunnels.

The Fort is divided into three main zones, with various galleries constructing the many layers of history.

#### The Life Of A Soldier

From their journey in a troopship, to the amenities in a fort, experience what life was like as a British soldier before the war. Students will also learn about the immigrants that worked for the British, and the various roles they play in a British fort.

#### Singapore During WWII

Uncover extraordinary moments in the war that changed the world, from the fall of Singapore, life during the Japanese Occupation years, to the events that led to the surrender of the Japanese.

#### Siloso Point

A walk through the longest tunnel within Fort Siloso leads them to the Fire Director Tower. As students look out into the vast seas, they will appreciate the importance of coastal defence.

For a more audio-visual experience, visit the Surrender Chambers to see the timeline of events that took place from the surrender of the British to the surrender of the Japanese. This is the perfect way to bring history to life for your students.
